Nontoxic product neutralizes odors

Dear Glenn: Several weeks ago, you mentioned a product that would take away odors. You mentioned the place to buy it was at several cigar stores. Could you give me the name of that product and the Web site so she can find it in her area?

Dear Randy: You are a good listener. The product is called Fresh Wave, (800) 662-6367, www.fresh-wave.com. It is nontoxic and nonirritating.

It neutralizes the odor instead of masking it. My producer, Dave, just used it to get rid of an odor in his car. Log onto the Web site and type in the ZIP code where your friend lives. You will get a list of places that carry it.
